She is responsible for overseeing public art, guiding the implementation of the City's Arts and Cultural Plan, and coordinating the grant process by which the city financially supports arts and cultural organizations. She serves on the Carilion Healing Arts Advisory Committee, the Roanoke City Public Schools Foundation, and the President's Advisory Council at Hollins.
